A celebration of neighbors helping neighbors, millions of volunteers from across the nation will unite to take on problems they see in their communities; and
- WHEREAS, Connecting with others and working together through volunteer service can bridge the differences that separate people and help solve serious problems; and
- WHEREAS, Community members are encouraged to take care of their part of Griffin during a community cleanup scheduled for October 25th. In conjunction with this event, the city will make available additional disposal facilities; and
- WHEREAS, Community organizations of all sizes are invited to perform services projects across the city in efforts to enhance the beauty and quality of life within the City; now
