Approval of Agenda

Motion/second by Commissioners Reid-Ward/Morrow to approve Agenda carried by a vote of 6-0.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

1. Receive comments regarding a request for a variance from Section 714, Planned Commercial Development (PCD), to reduce the side yard setback requirement from fifteen (15) feet to six (6) feet for a proposed development at 1447 North Expressway, submitted by Halpern Enterprises. *Planning and Development Director Toussaint Kirk will address*.

Director Kirk advised the applicant has requested a variance to a side yard setback from fifteen to five feet nine inches. Staff recommends approval of the request. Commissioner Morrow said he assumed the Board would approve, but he hoped for nicer landscaping on this project rather than the bare minimum. A Halpern representative was present. There was no public comment.

5. Consider approving purchase of five hundred (500) 95-gallon residential refuse carts from Otto Environmental Systems at a per-unit cost of \$46.00 each, totaling \$23,000.00 plus \$975.00 freight for a grand total of \$23,975.00. *Central Services Director Phill Francis to address*.

6. Consider sale of excess power by MEAG Power on behalf of the City of Griffin not to exceed 5 megawatts of Griffin's existing power portfolio. *Director Bill Bosch will address*.

7. Consider the purchase of Real Estate Easement for sewer easement on Vaughn Blake Post 8480 Inc. Veterans of Foreign Wars of the U.S. in the amount of \$830.00 for the Water and Wastewater Department of the Public Works and Utilities Department. *Director of Public Works and Utilities Department Brant D. Keller will address*.

Motion/second by Commissioners Reid-Ward/Morrow to approve purchase of a sewer easement for VFW Post 8480 as presented carried by a vote of 6-0.

8. Consider approval of Geo-Hydro Engineers for the testing of construction materials for projects PI 0008237 & PI 0008238 City of Griffin Intersection Improvements in the amount of \$25,500.00 for the Public Works and Utilities Department. *Director of Public Works and Utilities Brant D. Keller will address*.

Motion/second by Commissioners Morrow/Reid-Ward to approve contract with Geo-Hydro Engineers as presented carried by a vote of 6-0.
