Distributed renewable energy is knocking on the doors of our local businesses and residents, and we are all carefully watching the country's political and financial arenas with an eye towards the upcoming elections and the economy. The Mayors Summit is an opportunity for you to hear informed updates on what these various developments might mean to your local community.

- 1. Take I-285 E toward Macon for 14.3 miles
- 2. Merge onto I-20 E/GA-402 E via Exit 46 B toward Augusta for 62.5 miles
- 3. Take the GA-44 exit, Exit 130, toward Greensboro/Eatonton
- 4. At top of ramp, take a right onto GA-44/Lake Oconee Parkway for 7.1 miles
- 5. Turn left onto Linger Longer Road and go approximately 1 mile
- Turn left onto Lake Oconee Trail and go approximately 2 miles
