Dear Mr. Smith:


In our efforts to transform the old Meriwether Homes site into a more viable and aesthetically pleasing environment, the Griffin Housing Authority has renamed the on-site roads from Sunshine Road to Park Pointe Road and Pimento Road to Park Rd. These changes were made to rebrand the neighborhood into what we will call "The Park District".

Furthermore, we feel there is an opportunity to carry this beyond the current property footprint to include renaming the remainder of Pimento Road from Meriwether Rd. to the City Park entrance. By renaming Pimento Road to Park Road would assist in the rebranding of the entire neighborhood and more importantly identifying Park Road as a gateway City Park.

Therefore we respectfully request that this renaming will be considered by the COG and BOC as soon as possible, recognizing this will require community notification, outreach, and public notice.
