- Re: Spalding Hosiery Shoppe American Mills Old Building

Mr. Cropsey is representing the Sock Shoppe and the building expansion at the corner of East Solomon and N. 4<sup>th</sup> Street. Site drawings have been provided of the proposed loading facility and unfortunately the plans require the facility to be constructed in the public right-a-way.

Article 604F of the Unified Development Code (UDC) states that **no privately owned building**, service area, required off-street parking and/or loading facility other than driveways, access walkways and mailboxes shall be permitted within a public right-of-way. Therefore, by code and definitions permanent structures are not allowed to be placed in the public right-a-way.

Based on the information provided, Planning and Development Services Staff **does not recommend** the construction of a loading facility that encroaches in the public right-of-way on N. 4<sup>th</sup> Street.
