## **AN ORDINANCE**

AN ORDINANCE BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF GRIFFIN, GEORGIA, AMENDING THE TEXT OF THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE OF THE CITY OF GRIFFIN, GEORGIA BY AMENDING ARTICLE 7, TABLE 7.3, PERMITTED USES TABLE ZONING CATEGORY AND DEVELOPMENT TO PERMIT THE LOCATION OF CONSUMER FIREWORKS RETAIL SALES FACILITIES OR STORES AND CONSUMER FIREWORKS RETAIL SALES STANDS IN THE PLANNED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT ("PCD"); TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO RESTATE AND REAFFIRM THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE OF GRIFFIN, GEORGIA, AS MODIFIED HEREBY; TO REPEAL ALL CODE PROVISIONS, ORDINANCES, OR PARTS THEREOF, IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF GRIFFIN, GEORGIA, AND IT IS ESTABLISHED AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Unified Development Code of the City of Griffin, Georgia, is hereby amended at Article 7, Table 7.3, by enacting thereof the following:

## "Table 7.3. Permitted Uses Table for Zoning Category and Development

Consumer Fireworks Retail Sales Facilities or Stores and Consumer Fireworks Retail Sales Stands, meeting the minimum standards of NFPA 1124 for new and existing buildings shall be a permitted use in the Planned Commercial District."

<u>Section 2.</u> All Unified Development Code sections, any ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the foregoing are expressly repealed.

<u>Section 3.</u> Should any provision of this ordinance be rendered invalid by any court of law, the remaining provisions shall continue in force and effect until amended or repealed by action of the municipal governing authority.

<u>Section 4.</u> Except as modified herein, The Unified Development Code of Griffin, Georgia, is hereby reaffirmed and restated. The codifier is hereby granted editorial license to include this amendment in future supplements of said Code by appropriate section, division, article or chapter.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective July 24, 2016.
