On April 28, 2016 at approximately 2041 hours I responded in emergency mode to 229 N 9th St in reference to a subject possibly being struck by a vehicle. Upon arrival there were several subjects in front of 229 N 9th St arguing and being loud with what appeared to be one subject by the name of Willie Talmage.

I asked dispatch for more units to assist me at the location and began to talk to Talmage who was very upset. I was able to separate Talmage from the rest of the subjects and asked him what has taken place at the residence.

Talmage advised me that his girlfriend (Shantrell Milner) arrived at the residence and his family members began to attack her. Talmage said that they were upset with her due to some issues that Talmage and her had in the past. Talmage advised me that she was 4 months pregnant and the family members were throwing objects at her in an attempt to hurt her. I asked Talmage if at any point did she attempt to run him over with a vehicle or anyone else. Talmage advised me no she did not. I asked Talmage where Milner was at the time so we could check her welfare and he advised me that she may be at the Spalding Regional Hospital checking on her grandmother at room #224.

While on scene with other officers I walked back to my unit to ask dispatch to check with Spalding Regional Hospital for the subject. While in my unit I could hear a loud commotion going on as if someone was about to fight again. I stepped out of my unit and began to approach a black male subject (Quindis Flemister) who was shouting "Fuck 12 I dont give a fuck" and was shouting words to Talmage attempting to start another fight at that time. As I approached the subject he continued to shout and made comments and actions that made me believe he was going to fight with me. At that time I rushed Flemister and tackled him to the ground. While on the ground the subject began to resist arrest. Several times the subject was ordered to give up his other hand but would not. Cpl Jones #3474 arrived and assisted me while trying to keep an eye on everyone else to try and keep Officer Safety a priority. Flemister continued to resist, at this time I placed my left knee in the subjects neck area and pressed firmly to the ground to control the movement. I could feel Flemister trying o lift his head and began to threaten me to put my knee in his neck again. I then pressed again on his neck area to keep his head on the ground and sustain control over him. Once he was placed in hand cuff's I reached down and grabbed the arm and hair of his head to pick him up and get him into my unit before another fight broke out and we had to arrest another subject.

I obtained Talmages information and Milner's information from Talmage. Talmage also advised me that Flemister was his brother. I advised Talmage that we needed to speak with Milner to get her side of the events that took place at the location and to ensure she was ok. As of now I have not had any contact with Milner.

Flemister was transported to the Griffin Police Department and charged with Disorderly Conduct and released on a OR Bond. I also had EMS dispatched to the Griffin Police Department to check for minor scraps and bruises on Flemister. Flemister was also limping on his right leg that he claimed was from the scuffle of being taken into custody. Flemister's family member arrived at the PD and stated he was injured by the vehicle that Milner was driving. I am not sure how Flemister's right leg was injured due to the fact I have heard two different scenarios of how it was injured.

On 04-28-2016 at approximately 2043 hours, I assisted Ptl. Howell on a large fight call in front of 229 N 9th St.

Upon my arrival I observed a large crowd and a lot of people yelling at each other. The initial call was that someone had been struck by a vehicle. I started asking everyone in the area if anyone was hurt or got struck by a car. No one would really answer. I went and spoke to a group of subjects near a vehicle in the front yard of 229 N 9th St. I spoke to a female who stated that no one was hurt except maybe a Willie Talmadge. The female stated that his girlfriend hit him with a car.

Ptl. J. Howell was already speaking to Willie. Willie was very upset and I couldn't get much out of him. Willie and the group near the car keep yelling back and forth to each other. There was one subject that keep talking junk to Willie. He was a black male wearing some sort of green shirt and had deadlocks. Willie told the other subject that he was going to beat his ass again. The black male with deadlocks got into the road and begin to yell and throw signs up with his hands and telling Willie to meet him in the road.

At that time MPO. Johns went to go speak to the subject and I went with him. At that time I seen Ptl. Howell take the subject down. I held the subjects legs down and assisted Ptl. Howell on handcuffing the subjects. MPO Johns and Ptl. Guthrie stood close to keep the crowd away. After he was handcuffed I got up and started looking at a group that was coming to my right. Once it was safe. I then walked toward Ptl. Howells vehicle and assisted him with getting the subject in the patrol car. Once he was in the vehicle, I assisted with crowd control. I then went into service.

On Thursday April 28, 2016 at approximately 2041 I responded to the area of N 9th St and W Chappell St. in reference to Ofc. Howell calling for additional units due to a fight/large crowd. Upon arrival, I made contact with Cpl. Jones and Ofc. Howell who were speaking with one involved party and Ofc. Guthrie was speaking to several other subjects down the sidewalk. It appeared the situation was diffused as we collected information. Suddenly, a black male walked into the street throwing up hand gestures and bird fingers at the other individual we were talking to as well as yelling "fuck you" and what sounded like "fuck 12". The crowd began to get active again, so myself and Cpl. Jones ran toward the subject in the street in an attempt to advise him to leave or he would be going to jail for disorderly conduct. Before I could arrive to the subject, Ofc. Howell tackled him to the ground. This excited the crowd of 10-14 people who began to approach us. I turned around to keep them at bay as they advanced. A few moments later, several other units arrived on scene. I could not see what occurred after the take down as I was watching the crowd and dealing with one irate black male who was becoming belligerent. He asked for all the officers at the initial scene's badge numbers which I provided for him.

After Ofc. Howell left the scene with the arrested subject and the crowd calmed and dispersed, I left the scene as well. My body camera was not active the whole time as I turned it off when everything appeared to be calm, but it was re-activated after the scene was under control the second time. It was activated on initial arrival.

On 04/28/2016 at approx. 2041 I Ofc. J. Guthrie # 3554 responded to an address on N 9th St. in reference to a call in which an officer was calling for assistance in reference to a possible fight about to take place.

Upon my arrival I made contact with Ofc. Howell # 3537, Ofc. C. Johns # 3470, and a large crowd. I exited my patrol vehicle and began to try and disperse the crowd and help figure out what was going on. The party of people I spoke with advised that a female and her boyfriend got into a verbal altercation. The subjects advised that this caused conflict between members of the family in which were all at the household. The subjects advised that the female got into the boyfriends car and in the process of leaving the scene struck the boyfriend and his brother with the car.

I then went over to speak with other officers on scene to compare stories and to give Ofc. Howell (the case officer) the information that I had received. As I approached the other officers one of the male subjects entered the roadway and began trying to entice the boyfriend to fight. The male subject in the roadway began raising his voice, with two closed fists extending his middle fingers in a derogatory manner towards the male subject, and was yelling " fuck twelve " multiple time.

Cpl. Jones tried to yell at the subject to keep the crowd from feeding into the situation but the subject continued the conduct. Ofc. Howell and Ofc. Johns started walking over to the subject as he back peddled. Ofc. Howell then grabbed the subject to detain him as they both went to the ground.

I then noticed that the crowd began to become disorderly so I tried with several other officers to get the subjects out of the street and calm down. Ofc. Howell took the subject and placed him into the rear of his patrol vehicle as other officers began arriving on scene. My body camera was on during the duration of this call. The call was turned back over to Ofc. Howell.
