## Honoring the Accomplishments and Contributions of

### Dr. Randall Peters

- WHEREAS,** The City of Griffin hereby recognizes that Dr. Randall L. Peters, as President of Southern Crescent Technical College, has been an integral part of our local educational structure since October 1, 2010; and,
- WHEREAS,** Dr. Randall L. Peters believes that education is the key to improving the quality of life in the communities he has served and has spent his entire personal and professional life promoting educational programs; and,
- WHEREAS,** Dr. Randall L. Peters, as an officer in the U.S. Army, served as Assistant Professor of Military Science at the University of California with simultaneous appointments at Cal State Chico and Cal State Sacramento and as the Director of the National Science Center task force, a joint Army-private corporation to establish education programs in support of teachers and middle-school students; and,
- WHEREAS,** Dr. Randall L. Peters served as President of Heart of Georgia Technical College and served as Interim President at Middle Georgia Technical College and Ogeechee Technical College; and,
- WHEREAS,** Dr. Randall L. Peters demonstrated his love for his community by working in all areas of his life to grow the quality of life in the Griffin-Spalding County community and the service area of Southern Crescent Technical College and to provide opportunity for education at all levels and workforce development and was instrumental to the formation and development of the Griffin Region College and Career Academy; and,
- WHEREAS,** Dr. Randall L. Peters has served his community as a member of the First Baptist Church, the Griffin Rotary Club, the Chairman of the Board of Directors and Executive Committee for the Griffin-Spalding Chamber of Commerce, the Chairman of the Board of Directors and Executive Committee for the United Way of Spalding County, the Griffin Regional Education Support Activity (RESA) Board of Control, and Vice Chair of the Board of Directors of Communities in Schools in Henry County; and,
