The Spalding County Emergency Operations Plan has been updated by the Spalding County Office of Homeland Security and approved by the Georgia Emergency Management Agency. At this time, we would like to deliver attached copies of the Emergency Operations Plan to the associated departments and agencies. To be able to complete this and have a record of distribution, we will provide a disk or copy of the plan and the plan will have to be signed for as received.

As you may know, the purpose of the Emergency Operations Plan is to define actions and roles necessary to provide a coordinated response to emergencies within Spalding County. This plan provides a comprehensive framework for these roles and responsibilities of all associated agencies, while providing a link to local, state and federal resources that may be activated to address disasters and emergencies, ongoing planning efforts, training and exercise activities, along with federal guidance.

The Emergency Operations Plan should be kept in a secure location and have the ability to be referenced on an ongoing basis for preparation of an untimely event of a mass emergency. Please keep in mind that the Private Emergency Operations Plan contains secure and CONFIDENTIAL CONTACT INFORMATION OF PARTIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE PLAN. WE ADVISE THAT THIS INFORMATION IS NOT TO BE SHARED WITH ANYONE NOT ASSOCIATED WITH THE EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN. Also, the Public version of the Emergency Operations Plan will be included, which is a public format of the information and IS ALLOWED to be shared with the general public.

At the same time, we would like to request that all departments and agencies submit contact information for their department or agency such as contact person, contact number and address of department or agency. This information is important to ensure that our records are kept current.
